Get ready for an immersive adventure!

Omni Arena is a virtual reality experience that combines movement, gaming, and immersive visuals. To keep everyone safe and having fun, please review the following guidelines before participating.

Before You Play

Omni Arena may not be suitable for everyone. Do not participate if you:

Are pregnant

Have a heart condition or other serious medical condition

Have a history of seizures, epilepsy, or sensitivity to flashing lights

Have severe motion sickness or vertigo

Have neck, back, or joint injuries that could be aggravated by movement

If you have any concerns about your ability to safely participate, please consult a staff member before playing.

Participation Requirements

Guests must be between 52" and 80" tall to participate.

Maximum weight 285 lbs.

Participant must be able to move freely with the harness secured for safety purposes.

Secure footwear is required. No flip-flops or loose shoes.

Remove loose items such as bags, hats, or anything that could fall or interfere with the equipment.

During the Experience

Follow all instructions provided by Lumos team members.

Stay within the designated play area.

Be aware of your surroundings and other players.

Avoid sudden or reckless movements.

Stop Immediately If You Experience

Dizziness

Nausea

Blurred vision

Disorientation

Loss of balance

If any of these occur, stop the game and alert a team member immediately.

Supervision

Children should be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times while participating in or waiting for the attraction.
